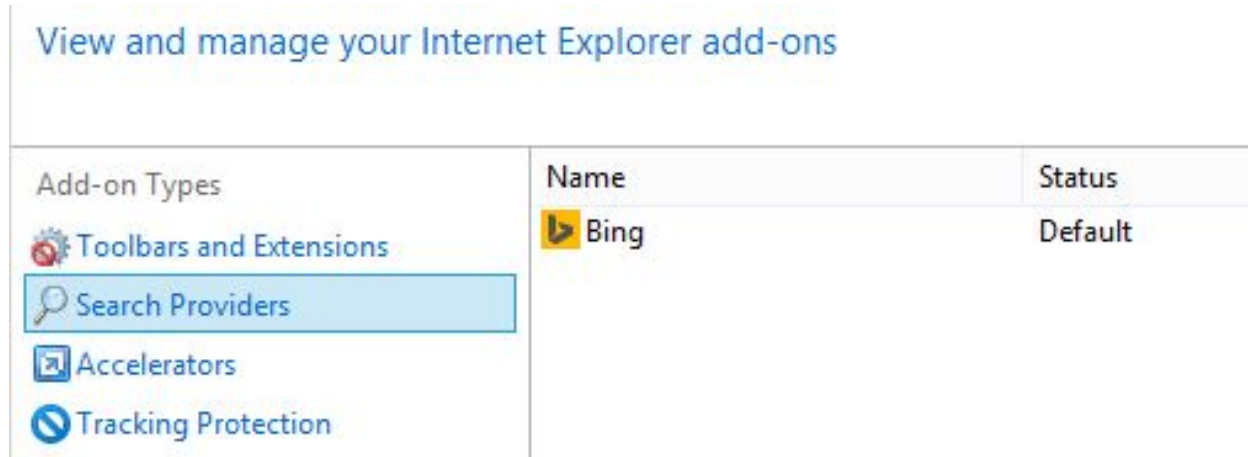


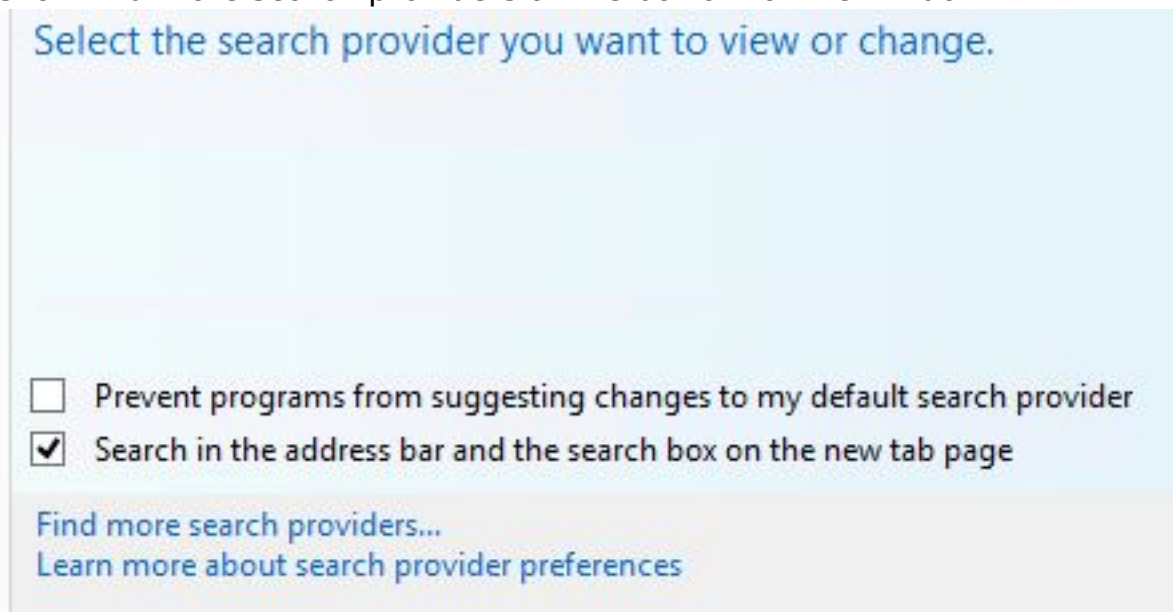
Change Default Search Location Internet Explorer

How to change default search location for Internet Explorer 11

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Click the Settings Icon (Gear / Cog) in top right
3. Select Manage Addons
4. Click Search Providers



5. Click Find more search providers at the bottom of the window.

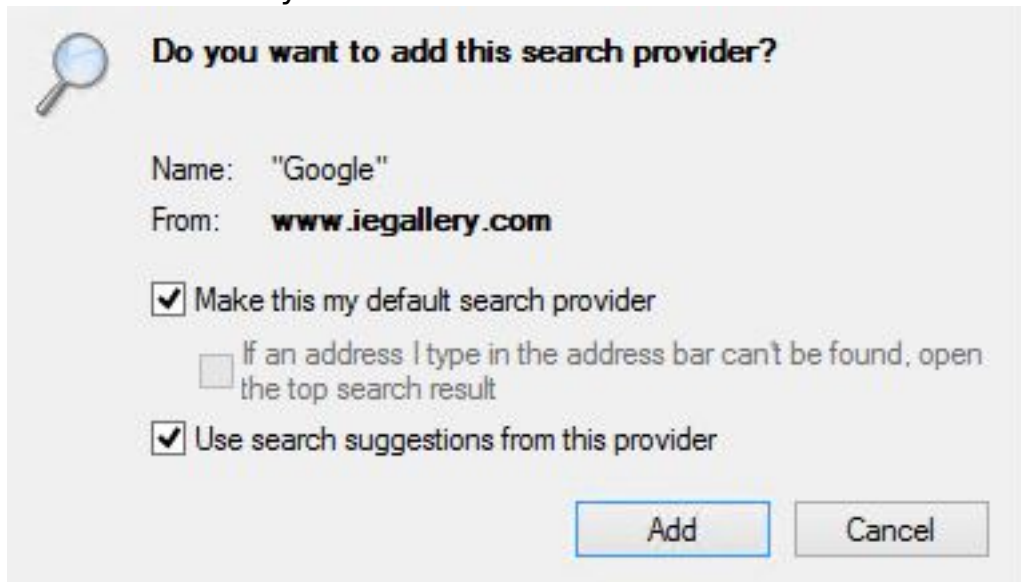
